My Experience in *FROZEN*

Since you were a part of the musical, *FROZEN*, you are not required to write a critique/review on it. Instead, you are being asked to write about your experience of being involved in a live stage production. Your paper should be at least two pages in length (DS) in essay (paragraph) format and **could address any of the following ideas (as well as any of your own)**:

These questions are provided to provoke thought/reflection. They are not questions to be answered in Q/A format, but rather potential things to think about and respond to in your essay.

- ◆ Was being involved in the musical different from what you thought it would be? Why or why not? What things surprised you or were different from what you had anticipated?
- ◆ What aspects of the live production do you better understand after having been in the musical? (Ex: time involved, team- building/members, role of a director, backstage crew, etc.)
- ◆ Were you pleased with the show's end product? Why or why not? (Give examples.)
- ◆ Were you pleased with your personal performance? Why or why not? (Give examples.)
- ◆ If you were the director, what would you have done the same or differently and why?
- ◆ Did you build new or better relationships while participating in the production of *FROZEN*? Describe.
- ◆ Has your experience encouraged or discouraged you from being involved in another production? Why?
- ◆ Has your experience "broadened your horizons" or given you a new take on theatre or on life?
- ◆ How will this experience impact your future?
- ◆ You may also include any of your own thoughts and ideas.

When writing, please use the following format:

1. **Open with a catchy introduction** that also includes the show information (title, dates, acting group's name, and location).
2. **Follow the introduction with a BRIEF synopsis** of the show that also introduces the character(s)/role(s) you played and your overall feelings of the experience.
3. **Describe your experience using EXAMPLES.** (Write about any of the items listed above....not necessarily in the same order – & not necessarily all of those items. You can include items of your own as well.)
4. **Closing paragraph wraps up your ideas and ends memorably.**

Your paper is due on _____. Please be honest in your feedback/analysis. You will be graded with the same rubric as your peers (**MYP Arts Rubric - Criterion D: Responding**) and counts as 10% of your overall semester grade.
