- Students must complete, over the course of the entire semester, **8 outside-of-class theatre hours** and respond to each experience in their **Theatre Hours packet**.
- When responding to each experience in the Theatre Hours packet, students must work to **evaluate the experience** based on both 1.) their experiences/learning in this class, and 2.) prior learning. It must be evident that the student is RESPONDING to a piece of art, rather than defining or summarizing it.
- Earned theatre hours must be **submitted within ONE week of the experience**. The packet will be approved & returned, and a final grade will be given when all 8 hours have been earned.
